**Foster Care Process** 

**Kindred Souls Foundation's view on foster care:** It is our intent to find the most suitable homes for the animals while they are waiting to be adopted. The foster family assists us in profiling the animal's personality, behaviors and needs prior to finding an appropriate adoptive home. Observations play an important role in ensuring the best adoptive placement. Fostering an animal companion is a vital part of carrying out our mission.

**Application process:** Once a foster application is submitted, it is reviewed to see if we have a current animal in need who fits the foster family needs. If so, a case manager contacts the potential foster family to go over the case and to answer questions. If the family wishes to move forward, the case manager will come out to do a home visit and go over the required paperwork. It is also the time the applicant(s) can ask questions about their role in the adoption process. *Only non-smoking homes will be considered to ensure the health of the animals.*

**Foster Care commitment:** Fostering an animal requires an investment of time as well as an emotional and financial commitment. Kindred Souls Foundation covers medical costs for the animal and supplies the foster family with the initial food, litter, and other items that may be relevant to the specific case. Foster parents are responsible for the following:

- providing on-going quality nutrition to the animal (when we receive donations of food they are extended to the foster family)
- providing social interaction, one-on-one nurturing, play, and exercise to the animal
- transporting the animal to appointments
- participating in adoption events
- participating in the adoption meet and greet(s)
- administering medication to the animal if needed
- keeping the animal in-doors (with written exceptions as per the specific case)
- maintaining a safe environment for the animal
- staying in contact with the KSF case manager and other KSF or CCVH members
- picking up donated food/supplies at a mutually designated locations
- providing access to the animal for photos, videos, events, etc.
- returning the animal companion to KSF upon request or if you can no longer care for him/her
